For a day's wages, a worker will be able to buy a small measure of wheat (a quart) for daily sustenance. But this is not yet a full famine, but exceptional scarcity. The phrase «do not damage the oil and the wine» possibly indicates property inequality, job or have low salaries. It is espethe polarization of society into rich and poor. The poor will be the majority and they will struggle for their existence during severe economic difficulties, which will lead many to turn to God. (1Cor 1:26-28)



The past year more clearly shows that we are living exactly in this period, there is no full famine but scarcity and poverty are increasing.

The pandemic has hit the economy hard, many have become even poorer. War and natural disasters have negative consequences for the economy of all countries. #### II. Our Goals and What We Do

The Aid in Difficulty ministry is aimed at four biblical categories of the needy: widows, orphans, foreigners, and Levites. To help people from these four categories of the needy, we use 12 main support programs for the physical and spiritual needs of people.

#### **WIDOW**

At all times, widows and abandoned wives have been socially unprotected people. We also include elderly people in the category of widows, who, due to various circumstances, are left without means of subsistence.

## **ORPHAN**

In the countries where we helping are many orphans. Many orphanages are visited by believers with the aim of paying attention to disadvantaged children and bringing a little joy into their lives by distributing gifts and Christian literature.

In the Aid in Difficulty ministry, we see ourselves as a «channel» or «bridge» between those in need and those who wish to help. We strive to provide information about the needs of people and ensure sponsors ways to help them.

# STRANGER

Life can present various emergency circumstances: someone suffered from a fire, flood, and other natural disasters; and someone found themselves in a war zone. In the category of «stranger,» we also include people who have found themselves in critical life situations (economic problems).

## **LEVIT**

Preaching the Gospel, instruction in faith makes people able to please God and do His will. People engaged in this spiritual work, we refer to the category of «Levite.» Supporting them is not only charity but also participation in their ministry. Also, assistance to various events related to evangelization.



# III. Our 12 Programs



**Domestic Animals** — Help widows and low-income families buy domestic animals and feed so that they can raise them over the summer period and thus provide themselves with meat.











**Food Packs** — Purchase of necessary food products for widows and those in need.











**Children Shoes and Clothing** — Help widows and low-income families purchase shoes and clothing for children.









**Potatoes** — Financial assistance for the purchase of potatoes for the winter period.















**Warmth in the Home** — Financial assistance for purchasing fuel during the winter time.















**Funerals** — One-time assistance following the death of a parent.



**Medical Expenses** — Financial assistance for medical expenses.



**Household Items** — Material assistance to widows and low-income families in purchasing necessary household items.









**Support Widows and Orphan** — Visiting widows and orphanages with the aim of evangelism, distributing gifts. Assistance to family-type orphanages.

**Natural Disasters** — For families affected by fires, floods, wars, and other disasters.









**General Fund, «where most necessary»** — used for urgent needs and administrative expenses.







#### 2023 Financial Report


All donations to Aid in Difficulty were used 100% for their intended purpose. In 2023, all expenses related to administration and fundraising amounted to 0.8% of the total income (total income includes donations and grants). The following explanation is an indicator of how we allocate expenses.



#### Allocation of Expenses

- All expenses for our programs include the cost of products, preparation, shipping, distribution, and administration.
- Expenses related to administration and fundraising are paid from donations not designated for a specific purpose or from contributions to the «General Fund.»
- When program expenses exceed donations, we cover them from the «General Fund.»

#### All Aid in Difficulty service staff are volunteers; no one is on the payroll.
